Overview

Camp MYstiC is designed for a wide variety of interests that include sports, STEM, arts & crafts, group games, nature exploration, swimming, field trips and more. Campers ages 7 - 14 are grouped by age (7-9), (10-12), and (13-14). Most camp activities are held indoors, with outdoor activities mixed in depending on the day. Before & after camp care are available each day.

In accordance with 105cmr430 this camp must comply with regulations of the Massachusetts department of public health and be licensed by the local board of health. You may request copies of background check, health care and discipline policies as well as procedures for filing grievances.

Field Trips

Campers explore and experience the Greater Boston area on several field trips. Campers must wear their Y- designated shirt given out on their first day of camp. Details will be included in weekly camp schedule located at <https://www.ymcamalden.org> or can be received at pick-up or drop-off. Campers will receive a shirt for each week registered up to five weeks. *All trips are subject to change based on availability, scheduling and weather.



Swimming

Campers will have the opportunity to swim throughout the week. Campers swim at the Malden YMCA indoor pool and Tufts Pool. All campers are swim tested before they are allowed to participate in open swim.

COMING TO THE PROGRAM

Registration

In order to register your child for a \$25 per session/per child deposit will be paid at the time of registration. The \$25 deposit will be

applied to the camp fee/balance. The remaining balance of each session will be processed on the scheduled draft date (Deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable). Registration and health forms (including physical and immunizations) must be completed in full and submitted at the time of registration in order to secure your child's place in camp. Parents may register campers before their session starts. All new participants after 5/15/2019 must become at least Y summer youth members (\$40) at the time of registration.
